Five Finger Gospel

Repeat the Five Finger Gospel with kids regularly so that they understand the basic message of who Jesus is and what He has done for them. Because this basic understanding is necessary before a child can enter into a personal relationship with Jesus, the Five Finger Gospel helps plant seeds of truth deeply in the heart and gives the child the ability to share the gospel with others. The hand motions help students remember it more easily. Make it more engaging and fun by:

- Inviting a student to lead it
- Having students say it in a funny voice (like Darth Vader or Scooby Doo)
- Once the students know it, have the leader say each phrase but pause at a certain word.
 Students shout the missing word as loudly as possible when the leader pauses.

God created me for relationship with Him.



Paying the price for sin, Jesus died and rose again in THREE days.



I am FORgiven when I repent and believe in Jesus as my Lord and Savior.
