Prevent through

Planned Teaching

- 1. Hook/Introduction
- 2. Describe a skill

- 4. Practice skill/role play
- 5. Feedback/specific praise
- 3. Give a reason (Why are we doing this?)

Praise (4 positives to every 1 direction/correction)

- 1. Specific Praise Specifically acknowledge and state what you notice the student doing. (Wow, you are sitting up and looking up! Well done!)
- 2. Effective Praise Match the specific praise with something tangible. (Wow, you sat down right when I asked you to and now you are looking up. That helped the entire group to focus and pay attention. That shows me you are a leader! (Possibly give incentive))

Redirect through

• Corrective Teaching

- 1. Praise/Empathy (I know it's been a long day and you're antsy)
- 2. Describe inappropriate behavior (Right now you are being loud and walking around the room)
- 3. Describe appropriate skill (I'd like you to sit in our circle and participate in our game)
- 4. Reason (That will show your respect for God and others and we will all have more fun)
- 5. Practice/Role Play (Come show me what that looks like for you to join us)
- 6. Feedback/Consequence (You are doing a great job sitting up and listening up!)

Corrective Strategies – Alternatives to saying "No" or "Don't do that"

- 1. Coupling Statement (Right now you are standing up. It would be helpful if you sat down)
- 2. Reality Statement (The reality is the sooner you sit down, the sooner we can have our snack)
- 3. Empathy (I get that sometimes we have other things we'd rather do than join the group)
- 4. Praise (I appreciate your eye contact right now)
- 5. Cool Down Time (I am going to give you a minute. During that time, please take 3 deep breaths)
